



Baptiste Lake Pike Tournament Saturday September 4th, 2021 at 9:00am Dock Rd. Public Boat Launch

Rules & Regulations

- All boats must be inspected by a tournament official at the start of the day. Boats will be subject to inspections at all times during the tournament hours.
- All contestants must be present for inspection and registration prior to 8:30am at the Dock Rd. launch.
- Tournament boundaries include all parts of Baptiste, from High Falls dam to the mouth of the Ripples and everything in between. **Elephant and Benoir** lakes are not included.
- All contestants are required to have a fishing licence and must have their licence with them at all times.
- Boat drivers must have a valid boat licence and insurance if necessary for their boat.
- Regulations for Pike in zone 15 is 6 for sport licence and 2 for conservation licence - sport licence holders will have the advantage.
- A minimum of 100 feet must be maintained between competitors at all times during the tournament.
- All laws in regard to boating, fishing and lifesaving equipment must be adhered to and will be enforced.
- Any infractions of the above rules will result in disqualification with no refund of entry fee.
- Although unlikely, if necessary and at the discretion of the Baptiste Lake Association, tournament days may be shortened, postponed, or cancelled due to unsafe weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Refunds will only be offered under special circumstances as determined by the management committee.
- Northern Pike are the only species of fish permitted in your boat or live wells at any time during the competition.
- Decisions of the tournament officials are final.
- Participants are encouraged to keep all Pike within their licence regulations.

Registration

- Entry fee is \$50.00 per boat. All contestants must register before August 15th, 2021.
- Prizes will be awarded to contestants based on each team's longest fish. You may bring your fish to the floating measure station at any time until 3:00p. Each team can only submit 1 fish for measurement so make sure it is the longest pike you have.
